As principal, it is a pleasure to welcome you to a school with positive, polite and engaged students, dedicated staff, and a strong committed parent community.

As a new Independent Public School, the school (Principal) and Board have signed a three year Delivery and Performance Agreement (DPA) with the Director General, Department of Education. The DPA clearly outlines the school's accountability in a number of areas including Teaching and Learning, Student Performance Monitoring, Resourcing and Support, Program Delivery, Compliance, System Requirements, School Board and Business Plan. The School Board, which is in the early stages of establishment, consists of the Principal, five parent representatives and three staff representatives. The Board members were elected earlier this year and have two year tenures.

The current focus of the school is on establishing a three year Business Plan against two key criteria; improving student performance and the student learning environment. This includes providing parents and staff with opportunities to engage in current education directions such as implementing the WA Curriculum, National Quality Standards (Kindergarten to Year 2) and the Early Years Learning Framework (K to Year 2); reviewing school policies; increasing parent engagement and consultation; upgrading essential utilities (electricity & reticulation) and improving facilities such as the K – Year 2 playground areas and outdoor classroom areas.

Beaconsfield Primary School offers a wide-ranging curriculum program with a strong commitment to the teaching and learning of Literacy and Numeracy. Specialist programs include music, physical education, art, Indonesian and an integrated design and technologies program, which utilises the school's kitchen garden.
